App	Cost	Comments
GENERAL		
iPad clock (incl. on iPad)	free	Timer great for motivation and staying on track
Over (Potluck)	\$1.99	Add text to photos, great for labelling and making learning more visual.
MATH		
Big Calc (Tioga Designs, LLC)	free	Auditory reinforcement that the correct number has been pushed. Really helps with accuracy on the calculator. Added features for an added cost.
Tell Time (Horizon Business, Inc)	free	Goes from basic time telling skills to elapsed time.
Top It (McGraw Hill)	\$1.99	Adding with playing cards. A bit more age appropriate adding practice for children that struggle with adding.
FINE MOTOR		
Letter Reflex (Binary Labs Inc)	\$1.99	Works on getting b's and d's, p's and q's the right way.
Dexterity (Binary Labs Inc)	\$3.99	Fine motor practice that keeps children engaged. One of the activities requires correct letter formation.

Phonics Studio (Grasshopper Apps.com)	free	Great articulation practice. I have recommended it to parents that want to give additional speech practice at home.
Pragmatics (Super Duper Pub.)	\$2.99	A language app that has some very practical situations and topics.

iWord Q CA (Quillsoft Ltd)	\$24.99	My favourite app. This is a word processing, word predicting app. Not only does it predict words but it reads words back to the student.
